He talked about some pretty great things but the thing that stuck in my head was that "if God can raise people from the dead and have Jesus walk on water and people healed from any disease, then why can't God not solve all of our daily problems?" Once I got back to the cabin to put my books away, I was immediately healed.

During the time I was at [name of camp], I fell and cut my arm. I went to [C.S. nurse], and I was asked "Is this true about God?" I thought about it, and all the pain left.

For the rest of the trip, I followed and rejoiced, and even though we had some long and tiring stretches, I felt so much energy and joy. Everyone else in my group stayed very positive, and we all had a great time.

...I was one of the readers for our testimony meeting, and I learned a lot on the topic, prayer. This helped me learn more about ways to pray and grow spiritually. When I was in athletic performance camp, I learned how to rely on God while playing sports and exercising.
